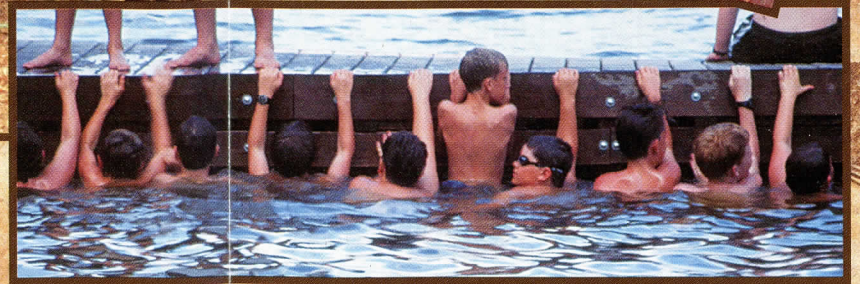
T-N-T - THE NEW TRAIL

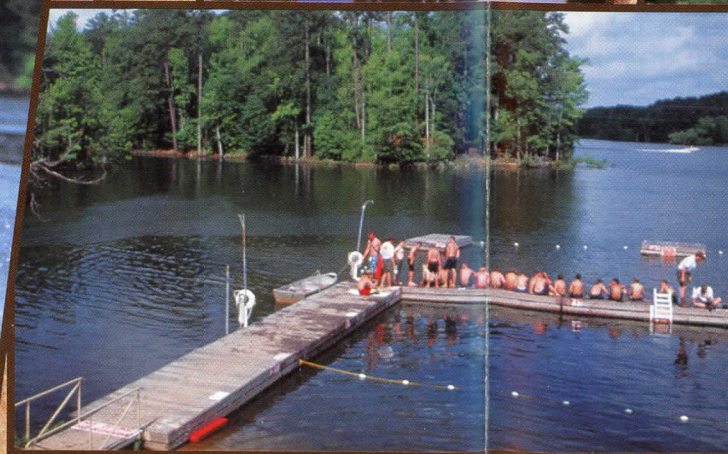
